## THE KALAHARI

Tswalu is more than a safari destination in southern Africa. Each guest's visit contributes directly to the sustainability of our conservation and social development efforts. These include the restoration of the natural environment to a pristine condition; the re-establishment and protection of biological diversity; the maintenance of the natural ecological processes of the Kalahari; anti-poaching; numerous on-site research projects; the provision of health-care services; a pre-school; and adult-learning facilities.

The word 'Tswalu' means 'a new beginning' and Tswalu Kalahari is driven by two ambitions: to create an inspirational experience for its guests; and a conservation vision, to restore the Kalahari to itself. This entails the management of the entire ecological system, including the vegetation and the available water resources to restore vital ecological processes which have disappeared in other parts of the Kalahari, thereby maximizing the diversity of life found in the region. These two goals sit in perfect equilibrium with each guest contributing directly to the sustainability of the reserve in a true model of eco-tourism.

Tswalu guests are in search of rarity, adventure, privacy, and inspirational travel. The Tswalu experience offers guests the platform to participate in one of the biggest conservation projects in South Africa.

## THE MOTSE

A covered deck leads to a private tsala and swimming pool.

Egyptian cotton linen, luxury toweling robes and slippers, and an adjacent outdoor toilet, basin and shower ensure comfort and convenience, while sundowners, snacks, and dinner give new meaning to the concept of glamping with your partner or the whole family – maximum of 4 persons. The Malori sleep-out deck maximises the exquisite panoramic views of the vast plains of the Green Kalahari and is orientated to showcase the incomparable Kalahari sunsets.

## GUIDE ACCOMMODATION AND RATES

Guide accommodation is available at the Kraal at a rate of ZAR 2 140 per person per night to include meals and soft drinks only served at the Kraal. Should you wish your guide to participate in meals and activities with their guests at Motse or Tarkuni, this can easily be arranged at a rate of ZAR 3 950 per person per night and will also include all beverages.

Please note that luggage (must be soft sided bags) is restricted to a maximum of 44 pounds (20 kg) on Tswalu scheduled flights, inclusive hand luggage. Extra seats may be purchased, at standard rates, should guests wish to travel with excess luggage (will allow for 50 kg / 110 pounds extra in soft sided bags). Complimentary storage facilities are available for excess luggage in both Cape Town and Johannesburg.

Transfers between the private hangars, and the main terminal building; rental car companies; and airport hotels are included in the above costs, but must be booked with reservations in advance.

Children under 2 years old fly for free, and will be seated on parent's lap.

### Payment and Cancellation Policy:

In order to confirm a reservation, a 25% deposit is required within 14 days of making the reservation. Please note that a reservation is not secure until this deposit requirement has been met. Tswalu reserves the right to automatically release any accommodation being held, where the required deposit has not been received.

The balance of the accommodation and all transfers must be paid in advance, and in full, no later than one month prior to the guest's arrival. Tswalu reserves the right to cancel the booking should payment not be received. If a booking is made less than 30 days prior to travel, full payment is required. All extras are settled at the time of departure. Guest will be responsible for any bank charges that may be raised against international wire transfers. Tswalu accept all credit cards. No additional administration fees are charged to process credit cards. Minimum 3 night stay from 20th December to 06th January.



### Cancellation Policy

Current –90 days prior to arrival a 25% cancellation fee will apply

89 – 45 days prior to arrival a 50% cancellation fee will apply

44 – 0 days prior to arrival a 100% cancellation fee will apply

(With the exception of the Christmas (15 Dec – 15 Jan) and Easter periods when all bookings, confirmed in writing, will be liable for 100% cancellation fees.)

Our cancellation policy is applicable regardless of whether payments have been received by Tswalu or not.

### Travel Cancellation Insurance / Cancelled or Delayed Flights

In the unlikely event of a cancellation of a booking, travel insurance must cover our cancellation terms.
