Complimentary storage facilities are available for excess luggage in Cape Town and Johannesburg. Transfers between the private hangars, the main terminal buildings, rental car companies, and airport hotels are complimentary but must be booked with reservations in advance. Children under 2 years old fly for free (if seated on a parent's lap).

Tswalu reserves the right to cancel the booking should payment not be received. If a booking is made less than 60 days prior to arrival, full payment is required.
