LOAPI: R2860 per day, divided into R715 each for your guide and tracker; R550 for your house manager; R440 for your chef; and R440 for general staff.

- Please note that luggage in soft-sided bags is restricted to a maximum of 20 kg (44 pounds) on Tswalu scheduled flights, inclusive of hand luggage.

- Complimentary storage facilities are available for excess luggage in Cape Town and Johannesburg.

VAT

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT POLICY

A booking confirmation is required 14 days from making a provisional reservation.

PAYMENT TERMS

Confirmation of booking	20% non-refundable deposit (this deposit goes directly towards Tswalu's regenerative conservation costs)
60 days prior to arrival	balance of payment

CANCELLATION POLICY

Current to 61 days prior to arrival 20% cancellation fee (non-refundable deposit applies)

60 days prior to arrival 100% cancellation fee will apply

Please note:

- Our reservations team is on hand to assist with all enquiries on a 'case by case' basis.
- Our cancellation policy is applicable regardless of whether payments have or have not been received by Tswalu and applies to all reservations. The deposit and payment policy excludes trade partners with pre-approved credit facilities.
